

TUITION PAYMENT: There is an annual registration fee of \$35 per individual, \$50 per family. Tuition is an annual fee based on 30 weeks of class and includes group choreography by RCDC instructors. For the convenience of our families, tuition is divided into 10 monthly payments and is due on the lst of each month, paid by credit card draft. There are NO refunds for missed or dropped classes. Tuition is based on enrollment not attendance.

COMPETITION FEES: Each competition has a set price per routine that all participants must pay. All entry fees must be paid by the required deadline per the Fee Schedule to avoid a late penalty. For any competition outside Central Arkansas, travel and lodging expenses will be the responsibility of each family.

LATE FEES: Any non-tuition fee (competition, convention, costume, etc.) that is outstanding more than 30 days will incur a 10% late fee. This company late fee will be applied to overdue accounts once every 30 days until the fees are paid and the account is current. Monthly tuition that is outstanding past the 15th will be charged a \$15 late fee.

DROP/DISMISSAL FEE: If you leave any RCDC Company Program for any reason, you will incur a \$150 Drop Fee PER ROUTINE. This includes injury, dismissal, relocation, and any other reason a dancer may not be able to fulfill their commitment to the RCDC Company Programs. When a company member leaves, it affects the entire RCDC team. This fee will be used for choreography, re-blocking, costumes, etc. If you exit a routine, an understudy can be put in your dancer's place. You will be responsible for loaning the understudy your costumes and paying all entry fees for required competitions/events.



PROPS: Choreographers may choose to have the dancers perform with a set piece or prop. This prop fee is divided equally among all dancers in the group. Prices vary depending on the size, as well as the construction materials. Prop deposits will post in October, the remainder balance (if any) will post after company dress rehearsal. Transport of props for solos, duets and trios is the responsibility of the dancer's family.

COSTUMES: Each routine will have a professional costume. Each costume will be approximately \$150-\$250 per the Fee Schedule.

COMMITMENT FORM: Dedication is one of the pillars upon which RCDC Company is founded. Therefore we require every dancer and their family to sign the RCDC Company Program Commitment Form. This contract details the number of routines and competitions, as well as the time, financial, and personal obligations required. We understand that families have other obligations, so we ask that you carefully consider your family's ability to fully commit to the program before you submit the form. Submission of the signed contract is due before choreography begins.

STUDIO RENTAL: Company members receive discounted studio rental rates: \$10/half-hour. All studios must be booked in advance through the front desk.

WEEKLY REHEARSALS: All group routines rehearse on Company Night. Rehearsals for each routine average 30 minutes. Select small groups may rehearse on fundamental nights if needed. Attendance is mandatory. Missed rehearsals cannot be made up.

with classes in their level or below, and all make-up classes must be completed within 2 weeks of the absence. You must get permission from the front desk prior to any make-ups. Attendance is required. Dancers may not make up over 50% of their fundamental classes.

ATTENDANCE POLICY: Attendance is a MUST for a successful dancer & a successful competition group. Dancers are allowed 2 absences in each fundamental class each semester. The schedule is set early so that you can plan absences accordingly. No absences are excused-every absence counts. If you are ill for any class/rehearsal and NOT CONTAGIOUS, you must still attend to watch/ take notes. If you ARE CONTAGIOUS and miss rehearsal, you must make up any missed choreography/cleaning with that particular instructor and it will be considered an absence. ANY MISSED REHEARSALS DURING THE WEEK PRIOR TO A PERFORMANCE WILL RESULT IN A FINE OF \$50 PER REHEARSAL. So much time, effort & money is put into preparing for competition that it is imperative every dancer be present during the week preceding an event. Performance attendance is MANDATORY. Dancers who miss a performance may be removed from the team for the rest of the regional season and incur the drop policy.





REQUIRED EVENTS: The Apprentice Company will attend 2 local competitions and recital. The RCDC Company will attend 4 local & regional competitive events, recital, and 1 national competitive event. The dates of all required events will be announced by auditions.
